NEW: JAN WILS

The Olympic Stadium in Amsterdam and Papaverhof housing estate in The Hague are just two celebrated designs by the architect Jan Wils. His later work has the reputation of being of lesser interest. This lavishly illustrated monograph argues that nothing could be further from the truth. Few realize that all new-build projects and 'Vinex' sites eulogized for their 1930s style owe their look to this trendsetter among 20th-century architects.

NEW: VROUWEN IN DE VORMGEVING

The role played by women in industrial design and applied art between 1880 and 1940 has never been so fully documented as in this Dutch-language book on 'women in design'. Originally concentrating on typically 'feminine' textile handwork like embroidery and weaving, more and more women later became graphic designers, bookbinders, gold- and silversmiths, professions formerly considered 'masculine'.

The book launch is at Galerie Binnen, Keizersgracht 82, Amsterdam, on Saturday July 7th, from 15.30. All are welcome.

NEW: ARCHIPRIX 2007

That Archiprix is a platform and springboard for talented architects is clear from the list of Archiprix winners for 1982.
