NEW: MAAK EEN STAD

Mechanized, expanded, bombed and reconstructed: from the late 19th to the mid 20th century, Rotterdam was the plaything of external forces. Grand schemes to give elegant and coherent shape to the city failed one after the other. One man who succeeded in profoundly influencing this unmanageable city was the architect J.H. van den Broek (1898-1978).

This compact paperback contains more than 280 illustrations, including many photographs taken by the author.

NEW: ARCHIPRIX 2005

Furkan Köse is the winner of the Dutch Archiprix 2005. Archiprix is the annual award for the cream of student projects in architecture, landscape and urban design. Köse designed an Islamic cemetery as his final-year project at the Amsterdam Academy of Architecture. The jury described his design as being of a high quality and successful in its endeavour to bring cultures together. Assembled in this year's Archiprix book, the top Dutch final-year projects of 2005 graphically illustrate the present state of play at the Dutch architecture schools.
