Avati is regarded as the pre-eminent painter of paperback covers in the second half of the 20th century. He was known in the business as the 'King of the Paperbacks'. In this lavishly illustrated book graphic designer Piet Schreuders reconstructs Avati's life and 40-year career in which he worked for all the major paperback publishers including the New American Library (Signet Books), Bantam, Avon, Pocket, Fawcett and Dell.
